HIGHLAND COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS: June 7, 2021

- 1. Approved forming a Pastor Search team of seven people plus Pastor Neil as an adviser. The first slate of names and on deck names and on deck alternate names were also approved. We hope to launch the Pastor Search Team in July.
- 2. Approved the recommendations from the Executive Ministry Team on developing seven major ministry teams to coordinate and oversee the many ministries of Highland Church. The Executive Ministry Team will now help flesh out the ministry teams. One is the Education Team, which oversees many important ministries: Children in Worship, Sunday School, Centershot, GEMS, Xtreme, Strong Tower, catechism classes, young adults and Bible study groups. Early steps will be communicated to the congregation.
- 3. Approved a recommendation from a task force, including our Human Resources Team, to seek a part-time Youth Director, beginning at ten hours a week. The Human Resources Team will publicize this position, conduct interviews with any applicants, and make a recommendation to the full council.
- 4. Discussed setting clear expectations for our next senior pastor, especially in the areas of pastoral visiting, administration that encourages our ministry teams, and being a presence with youth ministries.
- 5. Noted with gratitude the solid giving in recent weeks that brings us close to our budgeted goal and commitment at this point in the year.
