3. Three practical implications of infant baptism.

Theme: There is a triple biblical basis for infant baptism: God's leading role in our salvation, the scope of God's covenant, and the precedent of circumcision.

Charles Haddon Spurgeon: "Infant baptism is a slaughter of the sacrament."

- 1. Biblical perspective
  - No single Bible text proves infant baptism one way or the other
  - Infant baptism rests on broader biblical themes and principles

  - In the drama of salvation God is the lead actor; baptism is a sign of God's saving work, not of a human decision
