Our GOAL- to help them feel loved & to point them to Jesus.

HOW?

- By simply loving these women where they are.
- By sharing stories about life & how Jesus impacts our lives.
- Our simple steps of faith can liberate. "God gives life to the dead & calls things that are not as though they were." Rom 4:17b
- We are there to listen.
- To hear what is shared.
- To share the Word of God
- To bless
- To love
- To see the wounded, invisible
- To be available

A typical Tuesday night at the pink building starts with us praying outside in a vehicle.

We then go into the building with a meal.

We are greeted with hugs and hot coffee.

We pray together, holding hands and share a meal together.

We talk of faith, family, kids, and work. We strive to let the Spirit guide our conversations. We leave with hugs.

We are blessed to shine Hope and light in a dark place.
