Marion Food Bank is available to residents of the Marion area. Their pantry is open to walk-ins the 3rd Wednesday of each Month from 9:30 am to 11:30 am. Please call (231) 743-6092 for an appointment outside of this timeframe.

Feeding America Distribution Locations:

- Osceola: The Feeding America mobile food truck will be at the Marion Fair Grounds on May 18, 2020. Registration to begin at 2:30 am. You will enter at the South gate and exit on the North end. In order to comply with the Feeding America guidelines the following procedure will be in place: Once you enter the fair-grounds, you are to remain in your vehicle at all times. You will not be asked to touch or sign any paperwork. Someone will come to your vehicle to get your information. You are to open the window just far enough to talk to that person. After that you will proceed to the food area. You must have your vehicle ready to receive the food, your trunk/hatch/or bed of your pickup available for the food to be put there. No one will be reaching into the interior of the vehicles. You should also have some kind of box/tote or something to put the food into. After you receive your food you can exit at the north gate.
 - ***Volunteers are greatly needed to help distribute the food to each vehicle. If you are willing to help, please contact Carrie Thompson. Volunteers need to arrive by 2:00 pm.
- Missaukee: The Prosper CRC pick-up site has been changed to Thursdays from 4-6pm, NOT Fridays. This allows us to have fewer people in contact with one another and lessen the risk of spreading COVID 19. The other two sites, Lake City's Good Neighbor Pantry and Rehoboth Reformed Church will continue to distribute food on Fridays from 4-6 pm. We are getting food from Feeding America and anticipate continuing to provide it as long as food and funds are available and the need persists. We ask that your church families hold the Food Distribution project, and all the people involved, in your prayers for partnership, provision and protection.
